Email use

On Tuesday I sent a test message to the email addresses we have on our centralised system in the office. This newsletter is also being distributed via email. Local Authority area special needs inspection

Ofsted will be inspecting services for children and young people with special educational needs (who live in Cambridgeshire) next week. I am sending a separate letter all about that today as well as this newsletter. Please do take this opportunity to give your own experiences and feedback, both good and those that need improvement. This is not an inspection of the school but you can of course include comments about your child's experiences here if you wish.

Inside Drill

Today your child may come home and mention 'inside drill.' You will be aware already that all schools have regular fire evacuation practices. 'Inside drill' is the name we have in school for the opposite: in the unlikely event of a problem on site pupils and staff should stay in their classrooms, away from windows, until more information is received. All public buildings have similar drills and there is no need to be alarmed; I do not anticipate a problem. Today we are having our first practice of 'inside drill.'
