'Wake up its 7am and we need to be having breakfast by 7.30 as the bus comes at 8am'etc • Talk about what day it is, what they did yesterday, what they will be doing tomorrow, what is happening next week, next month and next year. Again make planning and the use of a calendar part of their everyday language • Encourage your child to dress and take responsibility for their clothing. • Involve your child with household chores such as hanging up the washing, folding clothes and putting the items away

We will play a range of maths games to explore number combinations, place value, patterns, time and other important mathematical concepts and to give opportunities for students to deepen their mathematical understanding and reasoning The second half of this term we will be concentrating on telling the time. Science Autumn Term 1- Everyday Materials We will compare, group, investigate properties including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity, and response to magnets Particular uses of everyday materials including metal, wood and plastic, the periodic table Autumn Term 2 – Weather We will explore and identify different cloud types. Understand the role of a meteorologist. Investigate and record weather patterns including cloud cover, wind, temperature and precipitation. Understand how weather can affect our everyday lives and wildlife including plants. Computing -E Safety -Writing E-mails -Photography and editing images Geography Autumn Term 1- The Arabian Peninsula We will learn about the physical features of the peninsula as well as population. Autumn Term 2- Eastern European explorers Ways you can help your child: • Talk to your child about number in everyday life encouraging them to use the right vocabulary – adding and subtracting, sort and grouping objects. • Talk about times within their routines – discuss mealtimes, bedtimes, time they get the bus and how many minutes to bedtime etc – Encourage your child to wear a watch • Talk about money – using cash and card.
