

Science – Autumn term 2016

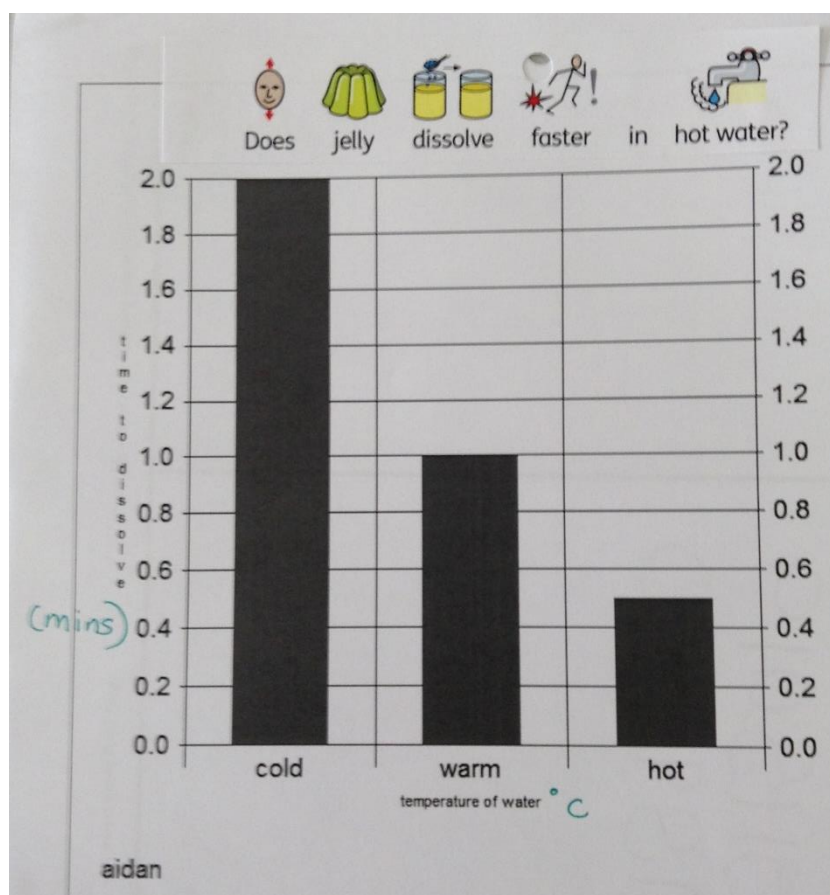
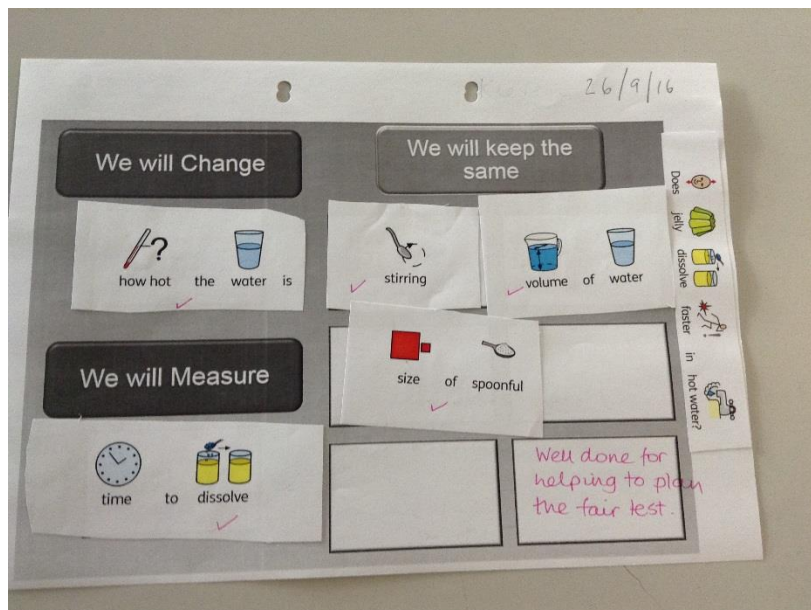
Key Stage 3 are enjoying learning about mixtures. Rainbow class made some giant bubble mixture and then we tried it out on the playground.
