



Practice Visual Perceptual Skills!

Shapes in a Room!

- Look around a room and find all the square, circular, and rectangular shapes.

Short and Tall!

- Gather items and look at them. Which are tallest and which are shortest?

Flip Flop!

- Look at an object. If you turned it upside-down, what would be on top? What would be on the bottom?

Memory Game!

- Gather 5 to 10 objects in front of you.
- Point to each object and name it.
- Tell a child to study the objects then to close her eyes as you hide one.
- Can she notice which object is missing?
- Try hiding two objects.
- Take turns.
- Hide all the objects. Ask the child to remember the objects and say their names. Put them back one by one.



Parts of a Picture!

- Look at a picture, box, or container.
- Name all the parts you see (EX: for a cereal box, you see 10 letters, 2 people, one bowl, one spoon, one napkin, extra writing on the bottom).
- Look on a counter. Name the objects.
- Walk into a room. Name the furniture.
- Look out the window. Name everything you see that is up high and everything that is down low.

Shapes in a Book!

- Study pages in a book. Find all the square, circular, and rectangular shapes.

Narrow and Wide!

- Draw a picture. Which objects are narrow? Which objects are wide?

Mirror! Mirror!

- Face another person. Take turns and copy each other's arm and leg movements. Move slowly then quickly.

Directed Draw!

- Draw a simple picture (EX: a dinosaur, an animal, a rainbow, a sky with a sun and clouds, a sky with a moon and stars, a boy, a girl, a man, a woman, a house, a school, a bus, a car, a truck).
- Ask a child to look at the picture. Ask him what he wants to draw first. What next? Then what? Then what?
- Step by step, draw the picture with a child. Now, draw it again. Great job!
