

**English:**

In English we will be studying the novel, 'The Hate U Give' by Angie Thomas. We will be looking at the themes of justice and racism as well as exploring language techniques and descriptive writing.



**Art/ Creative:**

In Creative we will be researching modern sculpture and the artists Goldsworthy and Calder. Students will produce a range of clay pieces inspired by their research.



**PSHE:**

Mental Health and Wellbeing are the theme for this term's PSHE lessons. We will be exploring what leads to poor mental health and how to maintain wellbeing.




**ICT:**

ICT will be concerned with e-safety, including what not to share, how to protect yourself from unwanted messages, safe and unsafe behaviour.



**Science:**

This term Electricity is the theme. We will be exploring what electricity is, what it does, the dangers it poses and experimenting with circuits.



**Maths:**

We will be looking at the meaning of place value, being able to recognise when we use numbers including zeros (0)



**P.E:**

In P.E. we will be exploring the sport of Orienteering. We will be refreshing our learning on following maps, directions and compass points.



**History:**

In History we will be exploring the role of the child during the industrial revolution. We aim to understand how, why and under what conditions children worked, and how the law changed to protect them.



**Skills for Life:**

In Skills we will be exploring the world of banking and personal finance, looking at current accounts, savings accounts, credit and debit cards.
