

<p>My Communication</p> <p>Communication and Literacy</p> <p><i>Fiction Stories on a Theme – Superheroes</i></p> <p>Become familiar with different fiction stories including superheroes, use PECS or communication boards to support you expressing what you can see / what has happened</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sequence events within the story Create a comic strip Become familiar with grammar within writing Express how the rhyme makes you feel, likes / dislikes <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share some of your favourite superhero stories to your child, you can read this to them or listen to it being read on YouTube or watch a clip of them Encourage your child to identify what they can see and what has happened, they be able to predict what will happen next with support of closed questions Discuss why you like or dislike specific superheroes, model identifying how it makes you feel and why – encourage your child to share their thoughts 	<p>My Body</p> <p>Physical Skills</p> <p><i>Gymnastics – Balance</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Engage within different balancing activities, such as walking along a bench or line, standing on one leg, jumping from point a to point b, copy different shapes with your body Engage within action songs Develop gross motor skills through sensory circuits Develop fine motor skills thorough funky fingers <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage your child to engage in balancing along a line, low wall or bench Encourage your child to create shapes with their body Encourage your child to engage in action songs and copy the actions with them Encourage your child to engage in some funky finger songs on YouTube 	<p>My Independence</p> <p>Skills for Life</p> <p><i>Enterprise</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify logos for different shops, become familiar with what they sell Identify likes / dislikes for different shops and their products Plan, advertise, create, sell and evaluate a product <p><i>Social Development</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Engage within turn taking games Engage within identiplay to develop functional play skills <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When you go to the shops, identify the shop you are going to and items they sell within the shop Engage within turn taking games
<p>My Community</p> <p>Personal Development</p> <p><i>PSHE – Healthy Lifestyles – Taking Care of Physical Health</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop an awareness of personal care / hygiene, practice washing hands, brushing teeth Develop an awareness of why it is important to keep fit, practice exercises around this <p><i>Religious Education – Sikhism</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop an awareness for different religions Become aware of the religion Sikhism and what they believe in, engage in some activities around this <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss the importance of looking after your physical health Encourage your child to wash their hands and brush their teeth independently Watch videos around washing hands / brushing teeth Engage in exercises to keep fit, copy action songs on YouTube, go for a walk / run, play on the park Talk to your child about Sikhism, explain that some people have different religions and that is ok – talk about your religion if you have one, discuss the similarities and differences with Sikhism 	<p>My Cognition</p> <p>Digital Literacy</p> <p><i>E-Safety – Searching for Information (Navigating Devices)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify how to stay safe online Search for information on different devices (iPad & laptop) <p>Maths</p> <p><i>Money</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify different coins / notes and engage within simple problem solving Role play buying things from the shop <p>Working World</p> <p><i>Science – Forces – Gravity, resistance, friction, levers, pulleys and gears</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Experience a range of pushes and pulls Experience a range of forces <p><i>Geography – Climate and Weather</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Become familiar with the seasons within the year, the climate within those seasons and begin to describe the weather Identify clothing you would wear within different seasons <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practice searching for favourite programmes on the iPad and / or laptop Encourage your child to buy something from the shop, talk about how much it costs, support them in finding the correct coins / notes to pay Identify different weathers and seasons, and what clothing you might wear 	<p>My Creativity</p> <p>Creativity</p> <p><i>Music – Music to Accompany Stories – Adding Sound Effects</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify different types of instruments Listen to different types of music which accompanies stories, discuss instruments heard Discuss likes / dislikes for the sound effects Create a sound effect for familiar stories <p>Ways you can help your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listen to different stories online which include sound effects, talk about the instruments you can hear Discuss likes / dislikes with different sound effects and how it makes you feel
