
Activities:

Mud painting

Materials:

- Thick paper
- **Dirt** (1/3 cup of dirt for each colour of dirt paint you wish to make)
- Food colouring: red, blue, green (optional)
- Water

To make a smoother paint, break up any lumps with the back of your shovel.

Equipment:

Shovel Bucket Sticks for stirring Paint pots Brushes or sticks Paper (or tree trunks)



Method:

- Scoop 1/3 cup dirt into each paint cup.
- Add just a little bit of water to each cup and stir with a stick.

You want the mud paint to be the consistency of a pudding. If it is too runny, pour off a bit of water or add a little more soil.

Have fun painting your mud faces.
