



We had a very busy science week, with sessions on the theme of 'Change'. Activities included

- making ice-cream in five minutes (and eating it!)
- making bouncy balls from latex and testing them
- making coloured flames





The activity which generated most excitement from both students and staff was the making of ice-cream. We also discovered that the same method can be used to make a 'slushy' using squash.
